Dan Moynihan's artistic development has been informed by 'too much cinema, inappropriate texting, bricks, driving a shit car, bad habits, taking things too far, renting, Magic 1278 radio 'the greatest songs of all time', not accepting baldness, other people, Bunnings Warehouse, not going far enough, eating alone in restaurants' – just to name a few. His work is often structured around the funny side of a story; and his carefully arrangement of objects are like the punctuation of a good joke. His new work visually recreates 'the remnants of a sincere gesture that didn't go down too well (and if research is anything to go by, understandably so.)'
