CHRISTOPHER LANGTON

Christopher Langton is a sculptor, painter and installation artist based in Naarm/ Melbourne, Australia. He makes innovative use of materials and profoundly engages with themes of pop culture, science fiction, and the interplay between biological forms and technological influences. Langton's works are often monumental, blending vivid aesthetics with unsettling undertones, which invoke a nuanced reaction of delight mingled with dread. His art frequently features oversized, playful sculptures and inflatables that resemble toys or cartoon figures, executed with a twist that suggests deeper, sometimes darker meanings.

Langton's creative process is technically intricate, involving custom-built machinery, which he designs and constructs himself. His exhibitions often include large-scale installations that create immersive environments, encouraging viewers to explore and interact with the space in thought-provoking ways. His work has been showcased extensively both in Australia and internationally, with significant exhibitions at renowned venues and works held in numerous private and public collections including: The National Gallery of Victoria, Melbourne, Monash University Art Collection, Melbourne, The National Gallery of Australia, Canberra, The Art Gallery of South Australia, Adelaide, Bendigo Art Gallery, Bendigo, Victoria, and Lyon House Museum, Melbourne, Tolarno Galleries in Melbourne and Hazelhurst Arts Centre in New South Wales.
